- A program that is certified by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection

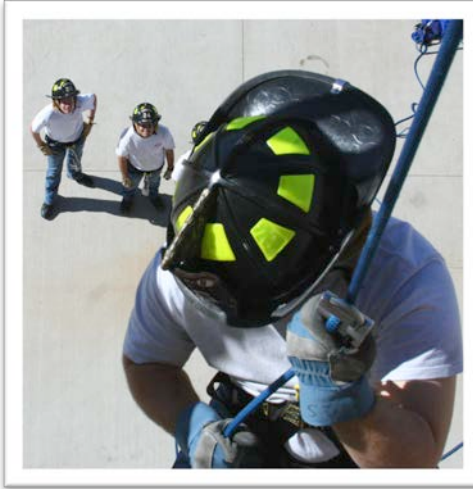
Admission Requirements

To enter the McLennan Fire Academy, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be eligible for entry into McLennan Community College and have either a high school diploma or GED.
- Be eligible to be a firefighter in Texas. (No felony convictions. Discuss any Class A misdemeanors with the Chief Training Officer before attempting to enroll.)
- Have an honorable or general under honorable DD214 (military veterans only). We strongly recommend that veterans meet with the Chief Training Officer before attempting to enroll.
- Have a medical release completed by your physician.
- Contact the Fire Protection Technology program to schedule an advising appointment.
